Awardod: Silver Star Date action: 13 August 1967 Theater: Republic of Viotnam

Reason: For gallantry in attion against a hostile force on 13 August 1967, near Chu Lai, Republic of Vietnam. On that night, an estimated enoug battalion launched a heavy attack on Company 8, 2d Dattalion (Airborns), 502d Infantry and unleashed a tremendous volume of autometic weapons, gromades, and rocket fire into the friendly positions. In the initial stages of the attack, one of the friendly machinegen positions received three direct hits from rockets. Specialist Four Ross, upon hearing the wounded mem call for a medic, immediately, and with complete disregard for his own safety, charged through the intense enemy fire to the disabled machinegum position where five men lay wounded. Disrogarding the beavy concentrated fire the enoug was placing on the machinegun position, Specialiet Ross began to administer the needed medical aid and pulled the man, one by one, to covered positions. During the night-long battle, Specialist Ross constantly moved through the heavy enemy fire, treating the wounded and giving his commedes oncoursement. When the platoon started running low on ammunition, Specialist Eoss began to resumply the positions with the needed emmerition, all the while he continued to treat the wounded and keep a constant vigil on those who had already been wounded. Specialist Four Ross' outstanding display of gallentry in action' and his intense devotion to duty are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, the Americal Divaion, and the United States Army.
