## AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR

FINNELING, CECIL P. FIRST LIEUTRNEHT, IMPICITATE, Company C, 2d Battalion (Airborne), 502d Infantry, 1st Brigade, 181st Airborne Division ATO 96347

Awarded: Silver Star

Date action: 5 October 1967 Theater: Republic of Victory

Reason: For 'gallantry in action against a hostile force on 5 October 1967, nair Chu Lai, Republic of Wietnem. While on a search and deatroy mission, First Lieutenant Kimberling's platoon was moving along a jungle trail when the pointman suddenly detected enemy activity. Lieutenant Kimbarling moved forward to make a reconversance of the suspected enemy positions and located twenty Worth Vietnamese Arry caldiers preparing positions. Lieutenant Kimberling immediately deployed his plateen to within twenty meters of the enemy position. He initiated the assault and valuantly led his men forward. As they charged forward, placing a transmious volume of fire into the energy positions, Ideutement Kimberling was struck in the leg and wounded. disregarding his painful wound, and shouting words of encouragement, he continued and directed the assault. As a result of ideutement Kimberling's heroic actions and inspiring leadership, thirteen energy soldiers were Milled and seven anegy Weapons were captured. First Lioutenant Limberling's outstanding display of gallantry in action and his devotion to duty are in beeping with the highest traditions of the military acreice and reflect great credit upon himself, the Americal Division, and the Mited States Army.
