## AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR

1. TC 320. The following AMARD is amounced.

PAVLANSKY, JOHN F. JR. FIRST LIEUTER NT, INFINITRY, United States army, Company C, 2d Battalion (farborne), 502d Infartry, 1st Brigade, 101st Airborne Division &PO 96347

Swarded: Silver Star

Date of action: 18 May 1967 Thester: Republic of Vietnam

Roasen: For gellantry in action against a hestile ferce on 18 May 1967 noar Die Pho, Republic of Victuan. First Lioutenant Pavlausky distinguished himself by exceptionally heroic action as his platoon was waving along a jungle trail and became engaged with an enemy: force concealed in well-fortified bunkers. During the initial contact the platoon sustained numerous casualties from the energy automatic weapons fire. Ideatement Pavlameky mored forward through the enemy fire to the point of contact and quickly reorganised his lead elements into a position to lay down an effective base of fire. He expessed himself to the vicious fire with complete disregard for his own safety while noving among the positions directing fire and physically placing his men into position. Several times he purposely drew the energy fire to enable his men to manauver. When the platoon suddenly received intense volumes of fire from its flank, Lieuterant Paylinsky organized and personally led three of his men in an assault on the enemy position, knocking it out with granades. He then shouted to the remainder of his platoon to mevo forward in the assault. Through his personal courage and inspired leadership, lieutenout Avlansky personally led his platoon through enemy positions and destroyed eight enemy bund: ers. First Lieuterant Pavlansky's outstanding display of wiquestimable valor, determination and aggressive devotion to duty while engaged in close combat are in keeping with the :1 ghost traditions of the military service and reflect the utwost credit upon himself, his unit, Task Perce Gregon, and the United Stateo And.
