Date action: 2 January 1967 Thrater: Republic of Victness

Reason: Gallantry in action: First Lieutenant Earls had placed his platoon into a defensive perimeter. Approximately three hours later, a numerically superior determined enemy element victorally attacked the defensive parimeter with such ferocity that six of Lieutenant Harls' wen were instantly killed. Realizing the possibilities of being oversum by the enemy, Lieutenant Eerla, with complete disregard for his own personal safety, charged forward to the area where the action was heaviest and began to reorganize his platoon. Being constantly exposed to merderous enemy automatic waspons fire and a heavy barrage of energy hand granudes. Lieutenant Egris moved from position to position giving his wen encouragement and pointing out enemy targets. On several occasions while rallying his men, hand grenades landed near him and his men and again Lieutenant Earls braved the murderous energy fire and personally picked up the energy greated and three them back at the analy. Having reorganized his platoon, Lieuterant Earla gave the order to assault the famatical enemy element. His implied men assaulted the apparior enemy force with such determination that the enemy ranks were broken and they were forced to make a basty withdrawal.
