GODBOIDTE; CORDELLS. , -CAPTAIN, INFANTRI, United States Army, Company C, 2d Battalion (Pirborne), 502d Infantry, 1st Brigade, 101st Airborne Division APO 96347

Awarded: Silver Star

Date zotion: 6 October 1967 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gellantry in action against a hostile force on 6 October 1967 near Chu Mai, Republic of Victram. While on a acarch and destroy mission Company C, 2d Sattalion (Mirborne), 502d Indantry, suddenly became heartly engaged with an energy element in well-fortified Positions. Captain (Redboldte, with complete disregard for his own personal safety, rushed forward through nearly enemy fire to the most forward point of contact. Quickly evaluation, Captein Godboldte then began to meneuver the third plateen to the rear of the energy element. Captain Godboldte immediately called for an air strike and then maneuvered the second platoen to the floak of the casesy positions as a blocking force. When the mir strike was made, Captain Godboldte exposed himself to the energy fire to direct the jet airoraft's fire effectively onto the enemy targets. When the air strike was terminated, Captain Godboldte directed his third platoon to initiate an assault on the enemy fortifications from the rear, while the second platoon was utilized as a blocking force. Captain Godbaldts observed one of his plateen leaders who lay wounded in an exposed area. Agrin with complete disregard for his own safety, Captain Godboldte rushed through the bullet swent area, picked up his wounded cominde and carried him to a safe position whore he could be given medical aid. As the enough element attempted to escape by the only route available, Captain Gadbeldte called for and directed fire from artillory and gunships into the ranks of the fleeing enemy. Captain Codeoldte's outstanding display of gallantry in action and hio-dovotion to duty are in keeping with the highest traditions of the willtary tervice and reflect great credit Turon Minself, the Americal Division, and the United States Army.
