## AMARD OF THE SILVER STAR

Awarded: Silver Star

Date action: 29 September 1967 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: For gallantry is action against a hostile force on 29 September 1967 near Chu lai, Republic of Vietnem. During an assault on heavily fortified enemy positions, Private First Class Ulrich had been given the mission of acting as rear security. Shortly after getting into position, Private Ulrich observed several energy soldiers approaching the rear of the platoon. Realizing that he did not have time to wern his commades, Private Ulrich, with complete disregard for his own safety, left his enverted position and placed himself in a position completely exposed to the approaching enemy. As the enemy neared his position, Private Ulrich single-handedly engaged them, killing two of the enemy soldiers and wounded another. During the defense of his rear security position, Private Ulrich was struck by enony fire and fatally wounded. His courageous and aggressive actions prevanted his platoon from being attacked from the fear and be undoubtedly saved the lives of many of his commades. Private First Class Which's outstanding display of gallantry in action and his devetion to duty, at the cost of his life, were in keeping with the finest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit woon himself, the Americal Division, and the United States Army.
