Rosson: For gallentry in action against howtile enemy on 29 September 1967, near Chu Lai, Republic of Vietnam. While or a patrel, Sergeant McDaniel's platoon received word that another platoon had become heavily engaged with an setimated platoon size energy element and wave planted down. Sergeant McDaniel's plateen towed to the battle area and began maneuvering to the Mank of the energy element. Initiating the assault on the first enemy bunker, Sergeant McDeniel mersonally led his men and succeeded in destroying the bunker and kulling two enemy soldiers. Immediately reorganizing his assault olement, he again personally led his men in an assault on a second energy bunker. A: the assiult element destrated the sacond burker, they were suddenly brought under fire from a third bunbar. with complete difregard for his own personal safety, Sergeant Velariel charged the enemy bunker in an attempt to descrip it. Sergeant NeDaniel was fatelly wounded by the intense fire ac he neared the bunker. Kis resmult element became so inclined by their leader's courage that they viciously asaculted the third bunker and destroyed it. Sergeent McDeniel's outstanding display of gallantry in action and his intense devation to duty were in beening with the finest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, the Americal Division and the United States Army,
