Reason: For gallantry in action sgainst a hostile force on 29 September 1967 in the vicinity of Gru Lai, Republic of Vietnam. On that date, Sergeam Balog's plateon became heavily engaged with an estimated two enemy squade emplaced in well-fortified bunkers. In the initial stages of the Nattle numerous friendly casualities were sustained. Sorgeant Balog frequently emposed himself to intense hostile fire while pulling wounded commades to covered Positiono, and corrying them to a nearby landing some to be evacuated. When he returned to the area of contact, Sergeant Balog, his platoon leader and one other man intlated as aggressive assault and sucerded in destroying four analy bunkers and killing six enewy anddiers. Twice, Sorgeant Balog fully exposed himself to hostile fire as he placed grenade fire into the cnew bunkers. During the course of the action, he was wounded in the shoulder by ensoy fire. Without concern for his own safety, Sergeant Balog continued to fire at the business until he succeeded in destroying them. When he ran out of aumunition, he obtained an enemy weapon and continued to move through the area. Suddarly, Sergeant Balog observed on exemy soldier in a well camouflaged spider hole and he rushed forward and killed him. Sermant Balog's outstanding gallantry in action and his devotion to duty are in keeping with the Alghest traditions of the military service and reflect groat credit upon himself, the Americal Division, and the United States Army.
