Resorn: For gallactry in action against a hostile force on 29 September 1967 in the vicinity of Chu Lai, Republic of Vietnem. Sergeart Wilson dietinguished kimself by exceptionally barnic actions when his platoon became engaged with an energy element of estimated oletoon wise firing from fortified posttions. In the initial burst of fire coveral canualties were inflicted on Sergeant Wilson's fire team. With complete disregrd for his personal safety, Sergeant Wilson rushed throught the hostile fire and mulled the mounded to safety. Ho then reorganized the fire team and began to moneuver against on enemy bunker. As the fire team neared the bunker Sergeant Wilson drahad through the intense enemy fire and leaped on top of it. Just as he was preparing to threw a grenade into the bunker he was hit by hostile fire and critically wounded. Displaying undounted determination Sergeant Wilson crawled to the aparture of the bunker and threw a grenade inside killing two enemy soldiere and neutralizing the position. Sergeant Wilson's unquestionable valor, fortitude and dediration to duty were in keeping with the finest traditions of the mulitary service and reflect great oredit upon binself, the Americal Division, and the United States ATAY.
