## AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR MEDAL (POSTHUMUSLY)

1, TC 320, The following AVARD is announced.

EASTERLING, RAPL K STAFF SERGEANT B6 United States Army Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion (Airborne), 502d Infantry, APO San Francisco 96347.

Awarded; Silver Star (Posthumously)

Date action: 22 April 1967 Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason: Gallentry in action: While poving up a secep, rocky, heavily regetated ravine, Staff Sergeant Easterling's squad was fired upon by a dug-in North Vietnamese element. The initial burst of fire wounded two men that were near the front of the formation, with complete disregard for his own personal safety Sergeant Easterling dashed through a withering hail of enemy automatic weapons fire to the forwardment position of his squad, After making on estimate of the situation, Sergeant Easterling deployed his squad on line and began to case wer on the energ. When the squad was in close proximity of the enemy position, Sergeant Easterling led an assault on the entrenched North Vietnamese soldiers. It was during this courageous action that Sergeant Besterling was portally wounded. Sergeant Easterling's courageous leadership so influenced his squad that it was able to sweep over the fortified positions and route the enemy. Sergeant Easterling's actions and demonstrated gallantry in action are in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit and the United States Army.
