Theaters composite of Vietnam Reason: For muliantry in action in the depublic of Vietness on 20 April 1968. Specialist Four Modride distance shed himself while serving as a rifleren with Company C, 1st Hartalian (Alrhorne), Solat Infantry, curing a combat operation in the Juang Dien District, Thua Thien Province, Regublic of Victors. Specialist our Matride's platoon, the land platoon, was suddenly and accurately taken under an intense barrage of mostile automatic weapons and rocket propelled grenade fire from its from and here Chank, sortonely conding the platon leader. Unhealtstingly, Specialist Four Mobride, with complete disregard for as own personal safety, brayed the murderous-nail of enemy fire to aid his fallen plateon leader. Specialist Four McBride carried the wounded man to saisty and then began administering first aid when the position received an intense valley of aniper rounds. Specialist Four McBride immediately located the major's location and maneuvered to engage the end. . hill alvanting through the aniper fire a bullet atruck his helmet and rendered Specialist Four MnBride unconscious for a few moments. Having recovered, he dauntlessly proceeded to destroy the sniper's cosition, killing two unipers. Specialist Four Marine then returned to the wounded plateon leader and carried him to salely. Through periodist Four McBride's intrepid courage and outstanding valor the platoon leader was successfully recovered and given immediate medical care. Specialist Four McBride's gallent actions and selfless courage were in keeping with the highest traditions of the mil tary service and reflect great oradit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
