Private Lamel a distinguished himself while serving as a rifleman with Company A, let Battalion, 501st Infantry, during a combat mission in Quang Tin Province, Republic of Vietnem. On the cited date, the lead platoon of Company A came under an intense volume of small arms and automatic weapons fire from wall-fortified enemy bunker complexes. Priwate lameles, maneuvered across the rice paddy to within fifteen meters of an enemy machine gum position. After eliminating this bunker with a hand grenade, he moved through the brush to the next enery position. Then, with complete disregard for his own safety, he stood up and killed the occupants of the second bunker with rifle fire. While attempting to maneuver on the third enemy position, he suffered fatal gunshet wounds. Frivate lambles is personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit and the United States Army.
