Remon: Barafillandakija fetigrikhila anganti izertlitazi energtiarakangiget Sergeant Seiffert distinguished himself while serving as a platoon sergeant in Company A. Let Battalion, 502d Infantry, on a combat operation near the A Shau Valley, Thus Thien Province, Republic of Vietnam. As platoon sergeant of the Pirst Platoon. Sergeant Seiffert was moving his platoon down a narrow mountain ridge when two platoms of North Vietnamese soldiers, entremched in bunkers overlooking the Third Platoon, opened fire with machine guns, small arms, and rocket propelled grenades. Pinned down and highly vulnerable to the enemy gummers above, the Third Platoon was suffering numbrous casualties and in desperate meed of relief. With complete disregard for his own safety, he voluntarily made his way under fire to the Third Platom's location across the narrow ridge. Attempts were being made to evacuate the wounded, but to no avail, as automatic weapons fire from an enemy bunker raked the position. Sermant Seiffert moved through the direct fire to outflank and then personally ascault the bunker without supporting fire. Mortally wounding two North Vietnamese soldiers with hand grenades and rifle fire, his courageous actions allowed the expeditious evacuation of the wounded and turned the tide of the battle against the enemy. Sergeant Seiffert's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
