Reason: For pallantry in action in the Republic of Vietnam on 15 May 1969. Private Vick distinpuished himself while serving as a mortar gunner in Company E, 2d Battalion, 501 st Infantry, during combat support operations in the A Shau Valley, Republic of Vietnas At arrecximately 0330 hours on the cited date, Fire Support Pase Airborne was attacked on an estimated bettalion of North Vietnamese Army Regulars. The enemy force consisted of an infantry element, mortar section, and sapper squade. Waves of insurgents stored the perineter from two sides and immediately penetrated the barbed wire and defensive mist. Tions of the bunker line. Enemy soldiers combed the fire base, hurling satchel charges and ensuring in hand to hand combat with men in night defensive positions and mortar crews. A setchel charge exploded beside Private Burnette, amoutating his les below the ince. Despite the loss of his leg, he continued to energe the enemy with his wearon. Maintaining a heavy volume of fire, he blocked the path for the enemy to pass his bush tion and gave the mortar crews enough time to assemble and prevent the mortar section from being overrun. He continued to pinnoint the locations of the attacking enemy to his fellow soldiers, even though in great pain and steadily weakening from loss of bloods. Private Burnette's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keening with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself his woit, and the United States Army.
