Lieutenant Hargrave distinguished himself while serving as a platoon leader with Company A, 2d Battalion (Airmobile), 501st Infantry, during an attack on Fire Support Base Menderson, Republic of Vietner.
While under heavy assault from enemy mortar and sappor fire, Lieuterert Margrave lead his plateon in defending the perimeter. Aware of the crevity of the situation, Lieutenant Hargrave deployed his mon into more effective fighting positions.
