Awarded: The Silver Star (First Oak Loaf Cluster)

Dato of service: 29 April 1970 Theater: Ropublic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the President of the United States under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved 25 July 1963.

Roason: For gallantry in action in the Ropublic of Victnam on 29 April 1970. Captain Mitchell distinguished himself while serving as commanding officer of Company A, 2d Battalien (Airmobile), 501st Infantry, defending Fire Support Base Granite, Republic of Vietnam. When the firebase came under attack from an enemy sappor force supported by grenado and mortar fire, Captain Mitchell rallied his mon for a counterattack. Despite intense enemy fire, he moved from position to position to brief his mon on assaulting a helicoptor pad which had been overrun by the insurgents. From an exposed position atop the command post bunker, Captain Mitchell co-ordinated the counterattack and directed his mon in successfully rotaking the helicopter ped. His actions contributed greatly to the successful defense of the firebase. While leading a swoop of the perimeter the following morning, Captain Mitchell detected enemy movement and at great risk personally captured a North Vietnamese Army soldier. Captain Mitchell's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States irmy.
