Awarded: The Silver Star

Date of sorvice: 23 April 1970 Theater: Republic of Victnam

Authority: By direction of the President of the United States under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved 25 July 1963.

Reason: For gallantry in action in the Republic of Viotnam on 23 April 1970. Specialist Banda distinguished himself while serving as a medical aidman in Company E, 2d Battalion (Airmobile), 501st Infantry, during combat operations near Fire Support Base Granite, Republic of Vietnam. While on a reconnaissance patrol, Specialist Banda's plateon came under fire from a well-protected enemy force. When one of the men in the lead element was critically wounded by automatic weapons fire, Specialist Banda rushed to his aid. He remained in an open area for a considerable length of time administering emergency treatment despite the intensity of enemy fire. Specialist Banda's personal bravery and devotion to duty were in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
