Awarded: The Silver Star Date of service: 13 March 1971 Theater: Repaiblic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the President of the United States under the provisions of the Act of Congress approved 25 July 1963

Reason: For gallantry in action while engaged in military operations involving conflict with an armed hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam. Lieutenant Colonel Dister distinguished himself on 13 March 1971 while serving a Battalion Commander, 1st Battalion (Airmobile), 501st Infantry, on a combo operation in Quang Tri Province, Republic of Vietnam. When Lieutenant Colonel Dister's helicopter, preparing to land at his company's field location, came under intense hostile fire, he detected numerous anamy positions. Jumping from the craft, Lieutenant Colonel Dister move to acopen area, and despite the extreme danger, called for and directed still fire on the enemy emplacements. Although seriously wounded, he remained emposed to the hostile onslaught and continued directing the artillary attack until he could be medically evacuated. Lieutenant Colonel Dister's gallantry in action was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
