## AWARD OF THE SILVER STAR (POSTHIE-DUSLY)

TAYLOR, ROYNALD E. STAFF SERGMANT 4-6 United States Army Co B, 2nd En (Abn), 502nd Inf, 101st Abn Div, APG US Porces 96317

Awarded: Silver Star (Posthumously)
Date action: 18 September 1965
Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Reason:

For gallantry in action: Staff Sorgeant Taylor distinguished himself by hercic action on 18 September 1965 while serving as squid leader in an airborne infantry battalion on a heliborne search and destroy operation in the Republic of Vistates. Almost immediately after landing, the small unit was pinned down by a heavy volume of hostile carll areas fire. One man was killed and one was wounded as the element attempted to push out of the defensive perimeter to line up with the main force. With complete disrogard for his own personal safety, Sergeant Taylor immediately moved under intense enemy fire to the wounded nam, he picked him up and began to carry him to safety. As he was returning to the defensive position, he was mortally wounded by enemy fire. The wounded wan he rescued was later evacuated to safety. Staff Sorgeant Taylor's valorous actions in close combat against an everwhelming enemy force was in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service and reflect great credit upon himself, his unit and the United States Army.
